Office of the Coordinator for 2010 Olympic and G8 Security



- Office created in October 2007 within the Government of Canada's Privy Council Office (PCO)
 - *PCO provides non-partisan advice to the Prime Minister, Cabinet and Cabinet committees on matters of national and international importance*
- Mandate to ensure:
 - coordinated federal response to the security challenges of the 2010 Olympics
 - adequate exercise program in place



Olympic Participation



- 5,000 athletes and officials
- 10,000 media members
- 25,000 volunteers
- 2 Million ticket holders
- 5,000 cultural performers and volunteers
- 35,000 overnight visitors/day of the Games
- 2 Billion television viewers
- 186 Venues

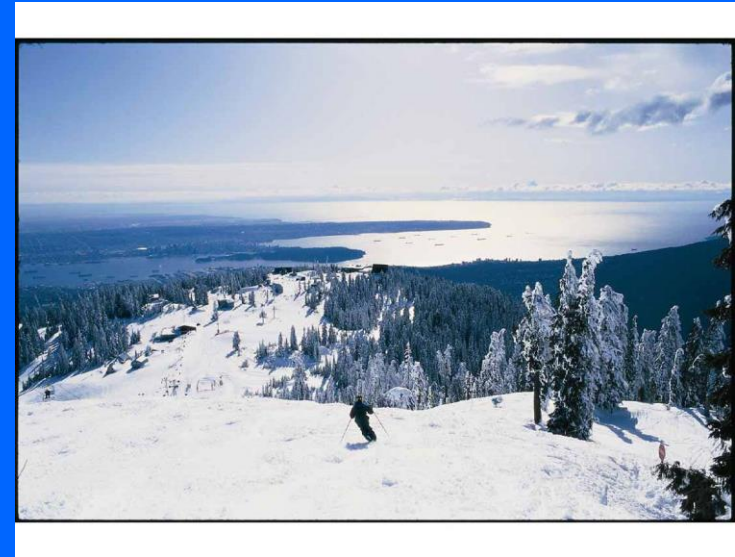

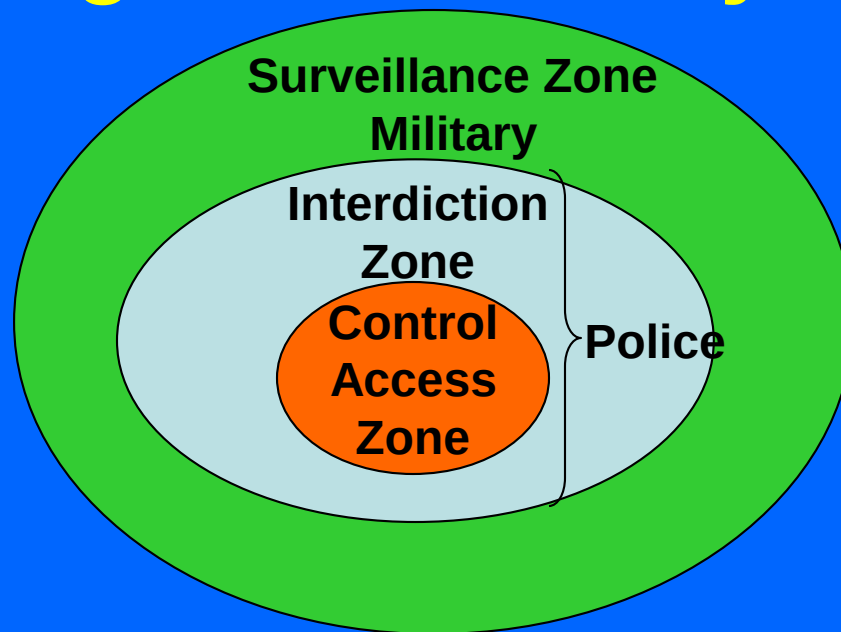
Integrated Security Planning



- RCMP led with support from:
 - Canadian Forces
 - Municipal Police Departments
 - Numerous other Federal and Provincial agencies
- RCMP, through Integrated Security Unit:
 - Develops security plan
 - Identifies shortfalls/gaps
 - Identifies resources to overcome shortfalls/gaps
 - Initiates request for military support



Integrated Security Plan



- Scalable in response to threat level
- Restricted airspace
- Contributions to security effort from RCMP, CF, CSIS, Transport Canada, Industry Canada, CIC, NAV Canada, CBSA, CATSA, Provincial and Municipal Law Enforcement
- Operational preparedness declaration - late Fall 2009
- Concentric rings of security
- Deployment of police officers, CF personnel, private security personnel

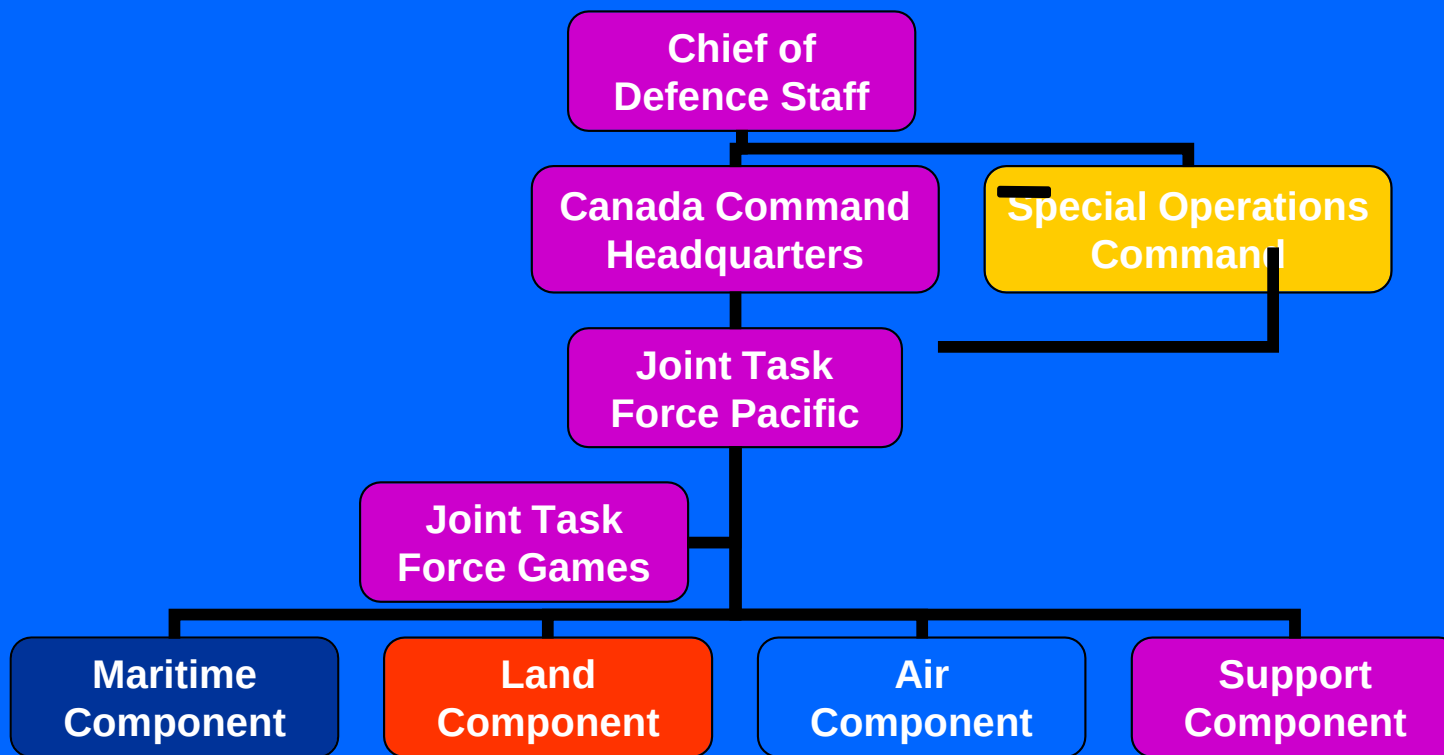


Provision of Military Support



- Minister of Public Safety formally requests military support from Minister of National Defence
 - Support provided as Assistance to Law Enforcement under the *National Defence Act Section 273.6(2)*
 - Initial authorization to assist in planning
 - Chief of the Defence Staff delegated authority to deploy resources
 - Authority to employ military resources remains with the Minister of National Defence

Canadian Forces Support (1)



- **Maritime Operations**
 - **Frigates & Maritime Coastal Defence Vessels (littoral waters)**
 - Surveillance patrol,
 - Intercept suspicious vessels
 - Assist in blockade operations
 - **Rigid Hull Inflatable Boats (shorelines, bays and fjords)**
 - Surveillance patrol
 - Intercept suspicious vessels
 - Assist in blockade operations
- **Land Operations**
 - **Combat Arms Units**
 - Surveillance patrols with all terrain & over snow capability
 - Armed Assistance to Law Enforcement to restrict access
 - General duties manpower pool
 - **Ground Based Air Defence Systems**
 - Radar and lowlight video capabilities
 - Surface to Air intercept

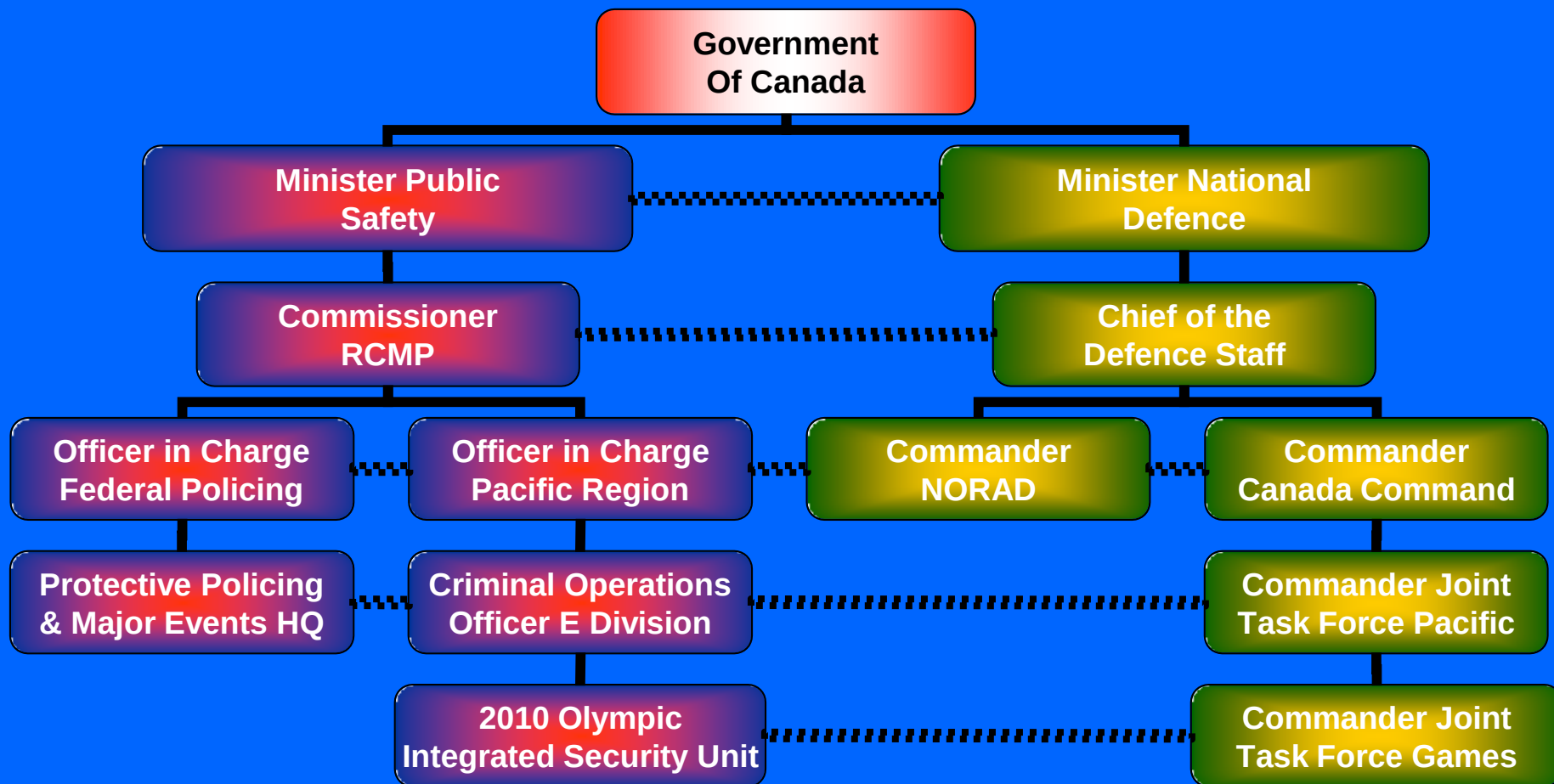


Canadian Forces Support (2)



- **Air Operations**
 - **Canadian NORAD Region**
 - Radar coverage possibly with Airborne Warning and Control System (AWACS) assistance
 - Airborne intercept
 - **1 Canadian Air Group**
 - Strategic airlift (transport aircraft)
 - Tactical airlift (helicopters)
- **Special Operations**
 - **Counter Terrorism Response Specialists**
 - **Chemical, Biological, Radiological and Nuclear Response Specialists**
- **Support Operations**
 - **Electronic Warfare**
 - **Geomatics**
 - **Logistics**
 - **Transport**
 - **Medical**
